*Name, describe and find out about the properties of 3D shapes through problem solving.

*Perform basic shapes, travelling movements, jumps and rolls in gymnastics.

*Travel over, under and around apparatus safely.

*Develop handwriting patterns through Write Dance and form curly caterpillar letters: c,o,a,d,g,q.
