

KEYWORD GAMES

Dear Red Class,

Playing fun games, little and often, will help you to learn your keywords.

Quick Keywords

Practise reading your keywords with a grown up then time how fast you can read them on your own. Try to beat your time.



Matching Pairs

Create two sets of keywords and place them upside down. Select two cards. If they match, keep them. If they don't match, replace the pair and try again.



Keyword Bowling

Stick each keyword to a skittle or a bottle. Roll a ball and try to knock down as many skittles/bottles as you can. Read the words to collect your points.



Keyword Cups

Choose 4 keywords and write each word on a cup. Ask a grown up to hide a small toy under one cup. Switch the cups and guess where the toy is hiding by reading the keyword on the cup.



Bean Bag Splat

Scatter your keywords on the floor. Throw a bean bag or a soft toy and try to 'splat' a word.



Bingo

Make two sets of keywords. Place one set of cards into a bag and divide the other set into two piles. Take turns to choose and read a card from the bag. If you have that card in your pile then keep it. The winner will be the first to match all of their cards.
