

WHAT WILL WE BE LEARNING?

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- *Name changes in our lives and how to cope with them.
- *Prepare for Year 1.

Communication and Language/Literacy

- *Read and spell words with adjacent consonants e.g. land, pink, snail, slip, drop.
- *Share and retell 'Whatever Next!' by Jill Murphy.
- *Write sentences using capital letters, finger spaces, verbs and full stops.
- *Write for different purposes e.g. speech bubbles, lists, instructions, simple stories.

KEYWORDS

Read: were, there, little, one, do, when, out, what. Spell: was, you, they, all, are, my, her.

Mathematics

- *Count in 1s, 2s and 10s.
- *Begin to count in 5s.
- *Understand addition and subtraction problems through bar modelling.

Physical Development

- * Develop throwing skills including bouncing the ball and overhead passes.
- *Play simple ball games.
