Communication and Language/Literacy

- *Take turns to speak and listen.
- *Speak in full sentences.
- *Listen to and retell the story of 'The Enormous Paella'.
- *Practise letter sounds and actions e.g. j, v, w, x.
- *Continue to blend and segment CVC words i.e. jam, wax
- *Read phrases and simple sentences.

Mathematics

- *Continue to develop basic counting skills.
- * Continue to develop number sense by using <u>concrete</u> apparatus e.g. egg boxes, cubes, counters and Numicon.
- *Develop an understanding of the concepts of more, less and same.
- *Find, name and describe 3D shapes.

Physical Development

- *Copy, create and refine motifs in dance.
- *Develop fine motor control through our music, movement and mark making sessions (Write Dance and Dough Dance).
- *Continue to use an efficient tripod grip and write name.
- *Wake and Shake- S Club 7 Don't Stop Movin'

<u> Fopic</u>

- *Find out about Spain and compare a Spanish village to Blackwell.
- *Design and make Spanish cakes.
- *Find out about 'faith' and what this means.
- *Listen to, copy and create simple rhythms and learn songs for our Christmas production.
