Here's what we will be learning in our different curriculum areas.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- *Name family members.
- *Talk about good relationships (kind, caring, trusting).
- *Find out how to be a good friend.

Communication and Language/Literacy

- *Revisit digraphs and trigraphs including 'or' (fork), 'air' (hair) and 'ear' (hear).
- * Read words with double letters.
- *Read words with two or more digraphs.
- *Share 'The Jolly Postman'
- *Explore story setting, characters and events through drama.
- * Begin to write simple sentences.

Mathematics

- *Use and understand ordinal numbers.
- *Begin to count in 5s.
- *Identify odd and even numbers.
- *Share a number of objects equally.

Physical Development

- *Develop running, jumping and throwing skills.
- *Continue to develop cursive letter formation, improving letter shape and size.
- *Wake and Shake- 'Better when we're dancing'

History

- *Ask and answer questions about the past.
- *Use sources of evidence to find out about the lives of our grandparents
- *Create a simple timeline.

Computing

- *Use cameras and a camera app.
- *Edit photographs.

Music

- *Listen carefully to pieces of music.
- *Learn and perform songs for Easter 'Singing on the Steps'.

Design Technology

- *Plan, make and evaluate a sandwich for Goldilocks' party at the end of our story book.
