ENGLISH

We are going to be exploring our literacy learning based around the 'Little People, Big Dreams' book about Maria Montessori.

The text links to the children's learning about schools, supporting their historical understanding well.

Spelling, handwriting and discrete reading sessions will continue.

MATHS

End of year expectations for mental maths include being able to recall 2, 5 and 10 times tables and division facts, find doubles and near doubles to 20 + 20, recall half of even numbers up to 40, + and – 9 from a 2 digit number, order numbers from 0-100 and use < and > signs when comparing them, recognising odd and even numbers, + and – two 2 digit numbers and partitioning numbers in different ways. Please continue to practise these at home to develop the children's rapid recall.

In our daily main maths lessons, we will begin by learning about measurement, including money, length, mass, volume and capacity. We will continue to apply new learning to solve problems.
