WRITE DANCE


A few photographs here to show and share what Write Dance looks like in the Nursery. Write Dance is our daily dance program which is designed to develop gross and fine-motor muscle, rhythm, coordination and balance. Every week we learn a new song, dance and then mark make. The dance movements accompany the song lyrics to incorporate a variety of physical actions. Above you can see us with paint, chalks and shaving foam with paint. This half term we extend with colour mixing and tools e.g. pens, chalks, brushes.
